## What you can expect

5 days of experiential training with the following contents:

### 1. Experiential approach

Lead a small group, take part in role plays, assist conflict partners as a third party in working out their own solutions, working in a group of no more than 20 participants. Organize, lead and participate in a CBCR Dialogue for your invited guests, a highlight of the week.

### 2. Planning and leading mediated processes

Learn the principles of community-based conflict resolution, discover your own value base, reflect on identities, stereotypes and prejudices, analyze types of conflict, try out models for reaching agreement, learn to use different types of group processes.

### 3. Reflection and sharing insights

Every experiential segment is followed by self and group reflection. Learning from the experience of others enriches individual learning.

### 4. The language of training...

...is English, additional translation where needed is encouraged. Participants receive two training manuals with theoretical background and tools for practical application later in one's own work or home context. A CBCR certificate is issued upon completion of the five-day summer school.

### 5. The language of the CBCR Dialogue...

...is BSK, with English being accommodated as much as possible. Participants of the CBCR Dialogue receive a certificate.
